



Bed Caddy



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Bedroom looking untidy?

Why not make yourself a bed caddy and have everything you need without having to get out of bed.

Can be made on all baby lock overlockers and combination machines.

Materials

- 4 x fabric strips 30" by 10"
- Wadding or double sided fusible wadding 30" by 10". I used Bosel In-R-Form Plus.
- 4 x fabric for large pouches 12" by 8" or 2 of main fabric and 2 of lining.
- 2 x fabric for medium pouch 10" by 8" or 1 of main fabric and 1 of lining.
- 4 x fabric for small pouches 8" by 8" or 2 of main fabric and 2 of lining.
- 30" of binding, 30" 5mm cord or 30" premade corded binding.
- Double sided fusible tape.
- Decorative thread to use for the wave stitch such as [woolly nylon](#).

These measurements are for guide use, you can adjust depending on how big or small you would like your caddy.

Tools

- Rotary cutter and mat
- Iron
- [5mm piping foot](#)

- Cut all fabric pieces ready for assembly.
- Sandwich the wadding between 2 of the large strips and iron on according to the instructions.
- Baste the pouch layers together.





- Finish the sides and then the bottom with the wave stitch.
- Using a darning needle thread the thread tale through the back of the stitch, snip and put some fray check on to hold in place.
- You now have a completed 'Bed Caddy' ready for use.
